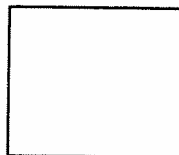

Camp Overview

The Youth Football Camp of Champions offers young football players an opportunity to develop their skills and learn fundamental techniques of all aspects of playing the game of football. Coaching will be provided under the leadership of for giants in the world of football. Coaches Bradley, Whaley, Render and Scott have over 100 years of championship experience.

Campers will learn from the best in pro, college and high school coaches. Two Super Bowls, two NCAA National Championships and two PA State Championships are included in their experience. Campers will also be coached by two of Penn States all-time great linebackers. Sean Lee and Paul Posluszny will give expert coaching tips on the fundamentals of playing football at the middle school, high school and college level. While at Penn State, they both served as 2 year captains and combined to lead the Nittany Lions to 3 Big Ten Championships and 6 Bowl Victories.

Eligibility

Boys from the age of 8 thru 14 are welcome to participate (14 year olds entering 9th grade in fall of 2010 are welcome).
