FAMILY AGREEMENT

USCAA Youth Football invests to provide a safe environment for players to learn the fundamentals of football. Eight or more games will be played during the season in which your son will have the opportunity to practice the skills he is taught. The philosophy of the organization may be different from other team sports in which your son has participated. All players will not share equal playing time and they may not play their favorite positions. The Head Coach will make all decisions relative to positions and playing time based on your son's ability, enthusiasm and participation in practice.

A player who signs up for USCAA Youth Football should be prepared to make a strong commitment to the team. The parents must also be willing to make the same strong commitment as well as understand that no amount of playing time or position is guaranteed.

Each family on the team will be given an equal number of home game duties (usually 2 — 3 per season). These include concession stand, down markers, etc. The parents are obligated to work their fair share of home game duties.

As parents of a USCAA Youth Football player, we have read the above information and understand and agree to the following conditions.

- To be supportive of the team
- To make every effort to study and learn the plays (as distributed by the coach)
- To make every effort to attend every practice and game on time
- To make arrangements to leave the field when practice is over
- To work our fair share of home game duties
